Harvard Retracts Invitation for Pro-Family Candidate to Speak at Law School

Statement by Independent Candidate for Governor, Pastor Scott Lively, J.D., Th.D.

My invitation to speak on criminal justice at Harvard Law School as part of a panel of Massachusetts gubernatorial candidates has been withdrawn by lead organizer David Harris. The justification offered was that the Center for Constitutional Rights lawsuit against me (for “Crimes Against Humanity”) would be a distraction. However, I think it is highly unlikely that Harris, head of the Charles Hamilton Houston Institute for Race & Justice at the law school, was unaware of my case when he issued the invitation. This novel and highly controversial case was filed in his own back yard in the Federal District Court in Springfield, Massachusetts, and has garnered international attention over the past eighteen months.

Rather, I am fairly certain this was a pretext and the real reason is pressure from the “gay” lobby.

I can’t say I am surprised. There are few people these days, even in conservative Christian circles, who have the moral fortitude to stand up to homo-fascism. The “gays” are by far the worst bullies in our society and just about everyone is afraid of them.

However, I’m turning “Yellow” Harvard’s lemon into lemonade and taking this as another teaching opportunity to offer simple, plain truth about the true nature of “gay” culture and its homo-fascist agenda.

This is my definition of the term:

“Homo-Fascism is a form of extreme left-wing radicalism which attempts to establish rigid totalitarian controls over public discussions and policies addressing sexual morality, and to punish or suppress all disapproval of homosexuality and related sexual behaviors.”

With this definition in mind, consider every news story of the past two decades in which a person from a pro-family perspective offered his or her opinion on the issue of homosexuality. From Carrie Prejean, to Brad Pitt’s Mom, to Rick Santorum, to Dan Cathy, to Phil Roberts (and all of the “little people” in between) my definition fits like a glove. Heck, not just two decades, it goes all the way back to Anita Bryant.

If you cross the “gays,” they try to destroy you! And if you don’t back down in the face of relentless persecution, they eventually sue you for “Crimes Against Humanity.”

My guess is this won’t be the last time we see homo-fascism influencing the 2014 gubernatorial race in Massachusetts.
